When that happens, the water from the wash and rinse cycle with all that suspended soil and lint drains too slowly and leaves deposits on your clothes. Most front load washers have a small door near the bottom of the appliance that can be opened to remove any lint or debris caught in the water pump filter. Top-load washers and standard top-load washers usually require removing the outer housing to access the water pump filter from the back of the machine. You may find lots of lint, coins, buttons, or even a sock that is causing a slow drain and leaving lint on your clothes. Cleaning this pump filter regularly will allow water to flow out more quickly taking suspended lint with it and not leaving it to redeposit on your clothes.
